Scope of Application

Data Protection

According to Art. 13 of the Federal Constitution and the Federal Data Protection Act (FADP), every person has the right to privacy and to protection against misuse of their personal data. In close cooperation with our hosting provider, we make every effort to protect our databases against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or falsification of data.

Processing of Personal Data

Personal data includes all information relating to an identified or identifiable person. This includes names, email addresses, and phone numbers. Information about hobbies, memberships, or websites visited also fall into the category of personal data.

Personal data is only collected, used, and transmitted by the provider if permitted by law or with the user's consent.

Access Data
